Luna Beberide Godello is aged on its lees for 6 months in stainless steel tanks. To make this wine we have recovered vineyards over 60 years old, making a clonal selection of the best plots of old Godello existing in El Bierzo. Aromas of fennel and white fruit, apple and pear. In the mouth we find a marked acidity, making freshness a main feature of this wine.

Luna Beberide

Young wine fermented in stainless steel tanks. With calcareous clay soils, its vineyards are on slopes between 600 and 750 metres above sea level. The Mencía Luna Beberide is characterised by its extraordinary fruitiness. Bright raspberry red colour, very fruity and mineral notes. The palate is balanced with persistent explosion of red fruits, raspberry. The finish is long, silky and slightly sweet accompanied by very fine tannins.

This wine represents the essence of the new "**Vinos de Paraje**" project at Luna Beberide located in our Finca Valdetruchas in Villafranca del Bierzo.

This vintage stands out for its exceptional balance between acidity and alcohol giving a fresh, elegant and silky wine. It shows a great personality expressing all the terroir, touches of minerality and scrubland typical of our vineyard.

The vineyards used to make Finca Luna Beberide are at least 60 years old. Slopes between 600 and above sea level. Clayey-calcareous soil and decomposed slate on bedrock.

Vino de Paraje “Valdetruchas” Luna Beberide

Aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. The early harvest brings out the freshness of the 2022 vintage. On the palate, elegance and balanced acidity prevail. It is fine with mineral notes, myrtle and undergrowth. Vineyards with a minimum age of 60 years. South-facing slopes between 700 and 900 metres above sea level. Clayey-calcareous soil and decomposed slate on bedrock. Art is indescribable, ineffable. It must be tasted.

PAIXAR

Vino de Paraje “A Serra” Luna Beberide

12 months in French oak barrels and bottled unfiltered. The vineyards are on slopes between 700 and 1000 metres above sea level, all facing south. Plantation density 1,20 x 1,20. The soil type is decomposed slate on bedrock. It is characterised by its Atlantic influence and a good temperature contrast between day and night. Paixar 2022 is a very complete wine. On the palate, minerality, balsamic notes, spices and the presence of scrubland are predominant. The wine shows all its personality given the rusticity of the Dragonte terroir and the elegance of the Mencia grape.
